The Teamsters Training Center is with the support of the ARRA taking care of the instructor and equipment.

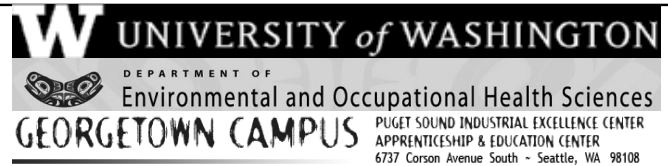
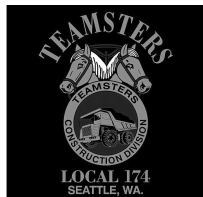
